

RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2018-16

Specifying the Salaries of Elected Officials in Roosevelt County, New Mexico

WHEREAS, the salary for elected county officials is established by statue; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico legislature has amended the statute regarding the salaries that can be paid to elected county officials; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County was classified as a B Over County; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission voted on July 17, 2012, for an increase in the Elected Officials salaries; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission approved Resolution 2015-17 on November 19, 2014 specifying the salaries of the elected officials in Roosevelt County, which shall be modified by this Resolution;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioner of Roosevelt County, pursuant to state law, that the salaries for elected positions in Roosevelt County shall be as follows:

Effective January 1, 2019, the salary for Sheriff is \$65,000, Assessor is \$60,125; effective January 1, 2021 the County Clerk and County Treasurer should be \$60,125; all Commissioners are \$22,832, and the Probate Judge \$20,024 and shall remain at their current rate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the appointed Chief Deputy Clerk, Chief Deputy Treasurer, Chief Deputy Assessor, and Chief Deputy Sheriff salaries shall be set at 93 percent of the office's elected official salary, once the new salaries go into effect, and shall remain at 95 percent until effective. The appointed Executive Assistant to the Sheriff shall remain at no more than 70 percent of the Sheriff's salary.
