

RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2019-21

A Resolution to the New Mexico Department of Transportation for the Roosevelt County Application to the Local Government Transportation Project Fund

WHEREAS, the "Sundale Valley Road Project" is an approved capital improvement project as noted in the infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan FY 2020-24 for Roosevelt County; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, has the legal authority to apply for, receive, and administer state funds; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County has agreed to provide matching funds at a percentage rate of 5 percent of the cost of preliminary engineering, construction and construction management and testing; and will also provide internal funding for the labor and equipment expenses necessary for the completion of this project; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County agrees to pay any costs that exceed the project amount if the application is selected for funding; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County has demonstrated the fiscal capacity to implement and administer funds allocated through the New Mexico Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County agrees to provide all ongoing maintenance costs for this roadway project after construction; and

WHEREAS, the Department of the Air Force 27th Special Operations Missions Support Group Cannon Air Force Base/Melrose Bombing Range, Floyd Municipal Schools and Roosevelt County supports this project and desires to receive funding; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County understands that another resolution must be submitted at the time the project is formally under contract with the New Mexico Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is at the time of application for Local Government Transportation Project funding:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners in and for the County of Roosevelt hereby authorized to submit application for project funding to the New Mexico Department of Transportation for "Sundale Valley Road" from the Entrance to the Melrose Bombing Range to NM 267 (3 ½ miles) Project and hereby commits to the such project as specified in the project application.
