- b. <u>Clerk</u> County Clerk DeAun Searl reported watching the legislature as several bills will directly impact elections.
- c. <u>Sheriff</u> Not present.
- d. <u>Treasurer</u> Treasurer Layle Sanchez reported a balance of \$3,576,816 in the general fund and business as usual.
- e. <u>Detention</u> County Manager reported 69 in custody, 20 female, 49 male, 1 in special management. There were 100 intakes and 91 releases with no errors, with business as usual.
- f. Road County Manager Amber Hamilton reported School Bus project on N RR G will finish this week then crews will begin caliche COOP projects. Routine maintenance is keeping everyone very busy.
- g. <u>Manager</u> County Manager Amber Hamilton reported contacting Elida, Dora and Floyd to schedule town hall meetings beginning March 21<sup>st</sup> concerning public input on the Land Use initial chapters.
- h. <u>Commissioners</u> Commissioner Dennis Lopez reported meeting with Tim Parker concerning the road project of striping that will commence on Hwy 70 and the crossing of North Main.

## New Business:

- a. <u>Discussion of Possible Road Closures Requested by Road Superintendent, Commissioners, and Land Owners</u>—County Attorney Randy Knudson brought a point of order to the attention of the commission: the action taken in the 02-21-2017 commission meeting, should not have been allowed due to not having appointed road viewers prior to voting to close the roads. In the matter of the closure of N RR AY and N RR 22, the commission heard from Eric Nelson from the State Land Office, Clay Moyers from the Game and Fish in opposition to closing and Brian and Sunny Osborn ranch managers in favor of closing. No action was taken at this time.
- b. <u>Update, Discussion, Direction and Action if Needed on 2017 Legislative Session Items and Bills</u> County Manager Amber Hamilton stated she is watching the actions of the legislature very closely, including the NMAC priority bills and those impacting the citizens of Roosevelt County.
