- d. Treasurer Treasurer Layle Sanchez reported a balance of \$3,136,618 in the general fund and is busy collecting the 2^{nd} half taxes, which will become delinquent on May 10th.
- e. <u>Detention</u> County Manager Amber Hamilton reported 67 in custody, 13 female, 54 male, 3 in special management. There were 107 intakes and 112 releases with no errors, 14 out of county detainees. The new administrator will start on May 1st.
