**A Resolution Terminating Emergency Ordinance 2014-02 and Proclamation Limiting Open Burning and Restricting the Use of Fireworks in the Unincorporated Areas of Roosevelt County**

**WHEREAS**, The Roosevelt County Board of Commissioners approved and adopted an Emergency Ordinance 2014-02 limiting open burning and restricting the use of fireworks within the unincorporated areas of Roosevelt County on March 11, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the duration of the ordinance was a 30 day period after date of adoption at which time the Board of County Commissioners may terminate the ordinance by resolution; and


**WHEREAS**, conditions warrant the adoption of a permanent ordinance that can be implemented by resolution as conditions warrant rather than on an emergency basis; and


