A Resolution Opposing the Legalization of Marijuana for Recreational Use within the State of New Mexico or Roosevelt County

WHEREAS, a petition from concerned citizens of Roosevelt County opposing the legalization of marijuana by the state of New Mexico or Roosevelt County was accepted by the Roosevelt County Commission at their regular meeting on July 15, 2014;


WHEREAS, the petition presented contained in excess of 800 signatures of concerned citizens that oppose the legalization of marijuana for recreational purposes by the state and the county;

WHEREAS, the Roosevelt County Commission desires to make a clear statement that as a commission Roosevelt County does not support any effort or future legislation that would legalize marijuana for recreational purposes by the state of New Mexico and that any bill that authorizes the use of recreational marijuana would be opposed; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Roosevelt County Commission opposes any measure offered by the New Mexico State Legislature to legalize marijuana for recreational use within the state of New Mexico or Roosevelt County.




