RESOLUTION NO. 2015-12

**A Resolution Authorizing the City of Portales to Operate a Misdemeanor DWI Supervised Probationary Compliance Program to serve Roosevelt County Magistrate and District Courts and Supports Judges in their Sentencing Appropriate Convicted Offenders to the Portales/Roosevelt County DWI Compliance**

**WHEREAS**, the Legislature enacted Chapter 11 allowing for Intergovernmental Agreements and Authorities and Article 6A allows for the Local DWI Grant Program Act, (see §11-6A-1 et. Seq., NMSA 1978 as amended) to address the serious problems of Driving While Intoxicated/Impaired in the State;

**WHEREAS**, a program is established to make grant and distribution funding available to counties and municipalities for new, innovative or model programs, services or activities to include the operation of misdemeanor domestic violence/DWI supervised probation compliance programs to prevent or reduce the incidence domestic abuse related to alcohol, DWI, alcoholism and substance abuse;

**WHEREAS**, the county DWI planning council and other governmental entities approval must be received in order to operate, within Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) and Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division (DFA/LGD) guidelines, a misdemeanor Domestic Violence/DWI supervised probation compliance which is allowed to charge offenders whom are sentenced to the compliance program fees for their supervision under Judgment and Sentencing imposed by Magistrate and District Judges; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Roosevelt County Board of County Commissioners understands and acknowledges that the City of Portales has administered the Local DWI Grant Program in the past and as the commission would prefer that the program continue to be administered by the City of Portales to accomplish the purposes of said program in the future.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Roosevelt County Board of Commissioners that all administration of the Local DWI Grant Program shall hereinafter be administered by the City Manager on behalf of the City of Portales to operate, administer, or make application for funds to the division in a manner determined by the division, on behalf of Roosevelt with regard to the Local DWI Grant Program.
