Roosevelt County resident Terry Truelock stated his business Valley Inc. was located on Franklin Road. The current condition of the road is difficult for his semi-trucks to pass. He requested a road closure or the County fix the road.

Elected Officials/Department Heads Report:

- a. <u>Assessor</u> Assessor George Beggs reported he is waiting on the mil levy rates from the state and business as usual.
- b. <u>Clerk</u> County Clerk DeAun Searl reported preparing for the 2015 Hospital Board Election, with District 1 and District 2 on the ballot.
- c. <u>Sheriff</u> Sheriff Chief Deputy Darren Hooker reported business as usual and working toward being fully staffed.
- d. <u>Treasurer</u> Treasurer Layle Sanchez requested that the presentation of the treasurer's report be moved to the second meeting of the month to accommodate the prior month's financials.
- e. <u>Detention</u> Roosevelt County Detention Center Administrator Mark Gallegos reported having 83 individuals in custody; 20 from Curry County (two of which were transported back to Curry for classification issues), 76 male and 7 female, 1 military and 25 municipal. GED testing was made available to 15 individuals through ENMU Instructor Tabitha Apodaca. Parenting classes are offered to the female individuals through 3rd & Kilgore volunteer Teresa Howard, with future plans for expanding to the male individuals. Administrator Gallegos is meeting with 3M today to discuss electronic home monitoring through ankle monitors for low classification individuals. His staff is assisting the sheriff with transports. Also reported was one officer position to fill.

- f. <u>GIS/Rural Addressing/Floodplain Management</u> GIS Technician Johnny Montiel reported two issues in addressing, no issues in floodplain, two subdivisions revisions and cell tower locations in GIS.
- g. Road Road Superintendent Ricky Lovato thanked everyone for the outpour of prayers and support for his family. Supervisor Juan Dominguez reported finishing up the first mile on Road 10 and planning the start of Road U. Currently crews are blading. Crews are being planned for the 8-10 miles of LGRF that must be completed before December 31st.
- h. Manager County Manager Amber Hamilton introduced the new Special Projects Coordinator Carol Acosta-Flores, whose first day is today. The State Department of Transportation will be holding the monthly meeting on September 17th at 8:30 a.m. that includes a presentation of current projects in District 2 by District Engineer Timothy Parker. An update from the Governor's office pertaining to the vacant Commissioner's position, administration can accept applications, resumes and letters of interest, all of which must be forwarded to the Governor's office. District Court is scheduled to move back into the courthouse on September 8th. In the "Waters of the US" court proceedings, which affect Roosevelt County, a North Dakota judge has blocked the ruling. County Manager Amber Hamilton reported attending a Local Growth Management Committee meeting with Commissioner Richard Leal.
