RESOLUTION NO. 2013-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSION TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

**WHEREAS**, the need exists within Roosevelt County for neighborhood improvement projects in several low and moderate income neighborhoods, and the County desires to apply to the Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for neighborhood improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Roosevelt County Commission has held 3 (three) public hearings for public input and comment during the 2013 application process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Roosevelt County Commission finds that there is a significant need to undertake the construction of a new facility for Arise Sexual Assault Program to provide adequate services to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, The Roosevelt County Commission determines that the construction of a new facility for the Arise Sexual Assault Program meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE ROOSEVELT COUNTY COMMISSION, NEW MEXICO, that**

1. Roosevelt County is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for the construction of a new facility for the Arise Sexual Assault Program;
2. That the Roosevelt County Commission directs and designates the Commission Chair as Roosevelt County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the Roosevelt County's participation in the New Mexico Community Development Block Grant Program.
3. The Roosevelt County officials and staff are directed to do any and all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
4. That the application be for \$500,000 of grant funds to carry out construction of a new facility for the Arise Sexual Assault Program;
5. That it further be stated that Roosevelt County is committing \$48,000 from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the construction activities of the facility for Arise Sexual Assault Program.
