Frequently asked questions of the Clerk's Office

- What number should I call for information about passports, divorces and name changes? Answer: District Court, the number is 575-356-4463.
- What do I need to get a marriage license? Answer: Both applicants must be present and show a photo ID with birth date, the license will cost \$25.00 (cash only).
- Do I need to get a blood test to get married? Answer: No.
- How long before I get married do I need to get the license? Answer: There is no waiting period.
- Is my marriage license good outside of Roosevelt County? Answer: Yes. It is good in any county <u>within New Mexico</u>.
- Will I be taken off the voter roll (purged) if I miss voting in an election? Answer: No. You must miss 2 complete voting cycles.
- Can I register to vote at age 17 if I will be 18 by Election Day? Answer: Yes.
- Can I vote by mail even if I am in the County on Election Day? Answer: Yes.
- Can I get a form for a deed or power of attorney from your office? Answer: No, but we suggest you see your attorney, abstractor, or local library; forms are also available online and at office supply stores.
- Can I get a copy of my Birth Certificate from your office? Answer: No. New Mexico Birth records are filed at the Santa Fe Department of Health. You may also try the Clovis Health Office. Their number is (575) 763-5583.
- Do I need and ID to register to vote? Answer: No, if you register in person, you do not need an ID. If you register by mail, you will be required to show ID at the polls, the first time you cast a ballot.
