

- A. **Consideration of Resolution 2019-10 In Support of the Second Amendment of the US Constitution and Declaring Roosevelt County to be a Second Amendment Sanctuary County:** Sheriff Parker asked the commission to pass this resolution to send a message to Santa Fe that the people will not be ignored. HB83 violates a person's right of the 2nd Amendment. The liabilities are endless.
