



RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2017-21

Authorizing the County Manager to Apply for Hardship Funds Through the New Mexico Department of Transportation Surplus Automotive and Major Road Equipment Program

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners for Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County is experiencing financial hardship and possesses a limited equipment replacement fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Roosevelt County Road Department has a lack of reliable vehicles to provide statutory mandated services to County roads and right-of-ways throughout Roosevelt County; and,

WHEREAS, assistance provided through the New Mexico Department of Transportation Annual Hardship Sale provides the opportunity for Roosevelt County to add to and upgrade its maintenance vehicle inventory; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO that the County Manager is authorized to request assistance from the New Mexico State Department of Transportation to assist Roosevelt County to be able to purchase surplus automotive and major road equipment from the New Mexico Department of Transportation Annual Hardship Sale.
