**2017-49 A Resolution Amending Resolution 2015-03 Changing
The Polling Places for the 2018 Primary and General Elections**

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Statutes Annotated 1978, Section 1-3-2 (2011) requires that no later than the first Monday in November of the odd-numbered year, the Board of County Commissioners shall by resolution designate polling places: and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that each polling place designated in the resolution complies with the provisions of NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-7 (2011), titled Polling Places: and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that those precincts that are consolidated to create Voting Convenience Centers meet the requirements of NMSA 1978, Section 1-2-4 (2011), will be available to voters of any precinct in the county to cast a vote at the Voting Convenience Center, will make voting more convenient and accessible to voters of the consolidated precinct, will not result in delays for voters in the voting process, and are centrally located within the consolidated precinct; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that each polling place provides individuals with physical mobility limitations unobstructed access to at least one voting machine.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVEED that the Board of County Commissioners designates the polling locations for the 2018 Primary and General Elections as follows;
