NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Roosevelt County that the Roosevelt County Commission hereby adopts the American With Disabilities Act Transition Plan & Policy, which is hereby approved.

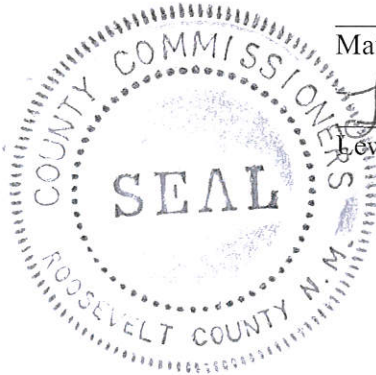
