



RESOLUTION NO. 2018-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE ROOSEVELT COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the need exists within Roosevelt County for neighborhood improvement projects in several low and moderate income neighborhoods, and the County desires to apply to the Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for neighborhood improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has held three public hearings for public input and comment on April second, third and fourth, May fifteenth, during the 2018 application process; and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that there is a significant need to undertake the Fairgrounds Storm Drainage upgrades and ADA Compliance to provide adequate services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Commission determines that the Fairgrounds Project meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, that

1. The County of Roosevelt is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for the Fairgrounds Project;
2. That the Commission directs and designates the Commission Chair as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the New Mexico Community Development Block Grant Program.





3. The County officials and staff are directed to do any and all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

4. That the full application amount be for \$750,000 of grant funds and Phased be for \$750.00 for the Fairgrounds Project.

5. That it further be stated that the County is committing \$37,500 from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the activities of the Fairgrounds Project.
