



RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2018-40

Authorizing the City of Portales to Submit an Application to the Department of Finance and Administration, Local Government Division, to Participate in the Local DWI Grant and Distribution Program

WHEREAS, the Legislature enacted Section 11-6A-1 through 11-6A-6 NMSA 1978 as amended to address the serious problems of Driving While Intoxicated in the State; and

WHEREAS, a program is established to make grant and distribution funding available to counties and municipalities for new, innovative or model programs, services or activities to prevent or reduce the incidence domestic abuse related to DWI, DWI, alcoholism and alcohol abuse; and

WHEREAS, the county DWI planning council and other governmental entities approval must be received in order to apply for grant and distribution funding; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to authorize the City to apply for and administer the grant on the County's behalf; and

WHEREAS, the City, on behalf of the County, along with participating agencies is making application to the Department of Finance and Administration, Local Government Division for program funding.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Roosevelt County Board of Commissioners that the Portales City Manager on behalf of the City of Portales and Roosevelt County and all participating entities is authorized to submit an application for Distribution and Grant Program funding under the regulations established by the Local Government Division.
