Elected Officials/Department Heads Report:

- a. <u>RCCDC</u> RCCDC Director Stan Livengood reported that work is being done on the website. A traffic count report was handed out to the commission board.
- b. <u>Treasurer</u> Treasurer Nancy Belcher reported 1,800 delinquent tax letters have been sent out and that \$1,250,000 had to be taken out of reserves this month leaving \$1,800,000 in reserve.
- c. Sheriff Under Sheriff Malin Parker reports business as usual.
- d. <u>Detention</u> Detention Center Administrator David Casanova reported that we have 2 juveniles in Quay County, 112 inmates housed in the detention center, 18 female, 6 from Colfax, 32 from Eddy County, 2 from Curry County.
- e. <u>Clerk</u> County Clerk DeAun Searl reported business as usual.
- f. Road Road Superintendent Ricky Lovato reported working on washouts, road 18 from W to AB was started last week and was washed out work is ongoing. He is waiting on the environmental assessment to come in. The quote was approximately \$10,000 and that will go up \$500 per each finding. Shredding will start as soon as the bar ditches dry up.
- g. Administration County Manager Charlene Webb reported business as usual.
- h. <u>Commissioner</u> Commissioner Kendell Buzard reported that Roosevelt County has officially joined the law suit with the Permian Basin.

Old Business:

<u>Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Resolution 2014-31 Declaring a Fire Danger Emergency in Roosevelt County</u> – Motion to lift the burn ban was made by Commissioner Richard Leal, with a second by Commissioner Scott Burton. 4 yes votes by roll call.

New Business:

a. Request to Dispose of Two International Dump Trucks for the Road Department – Road Superintendent Ricky Lovato requested to dispose of two obsolete dump trucks that have been parked and not used in years. Motion to dispose was made by Commissioner Kendell Buzard, with a second from Commissioner Scott Burton. 4 yes votes

- b. <u>Discussion Regarding Subdivision Ordinance Revision</u> County Attorney Rick Queener recommended that the ordinance remain in place as is. The attachment, Claim of Exemption, needs to be amended. The board requests Rick Queener to revise the Claim of Exemption.
- c. <u>Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Courthouse HVAC Renovations</u> Williamson Restoration Dennis Gershel reported that the original timeline to have the temporary trailers in the parking lot has been pushed back. The site maps were available for the commission. C.I.D. should have permits soon. The temporary trailers should be here by end of week, tied down and plumbed by next week. There will be a fence around the perimeter. The cost of this project has gone from 2 million to 2.9 million with a 9 month completion date. No Action Taken.

<u>Contracts – Agreements – Procurements:</u>

a. <u>Approve Contract for AirMedCare Network</u> – County Manager Charlene Webb stated this is an annual renewal for the payroll deduction for employees for Aero Care Air Ambulance. Motion to approve was approve was made by Commissioner Richard Leal, with a second from Scott Burton. 4 yes votes.

- a. Adopt Ordinance 2014-05 An Ordinance Dedicating in Quarterly Installments, An Amount Equal to a Gross Receipts Reported During the Prior Fiscal Year by Persons Engaged in Business in the County to the Newly Created Safety Net Care Pool Fund; and Providing an Effective Date of Transferring. County Manager Charlene Webb stated this ordinance will replace sole community provider and will send up the equivalent of 1/12th gross receipts. Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Scott Burton, with a second by Commissioner Kendell Buzard. 4 yes votes by roll call.
- b. Notice of Intent to Adopt Ordinance 2014-07 An Ordinance Establishing a Special Procedure for Administration of Taxes on Real Property Divided or Combined Prior to the Recordation of the Plat or Deed Evidencing said Transfer of Real Property and Requiring a Certificate Issued by the Roosevelt County Treasurer Establishing that Property Tax Obligation are Current Prior to any Subdivision Plat or Claim of Exemption. Motion to table was made by Commissioner Kendell Buzard with a second from Commissioner Richard Leal. 4 yes votes by roll call.
