Requesting the United States Air Force Fence Road North Roosevelt Road AV From US 60/84 Approximately Five Miles to the North Entrance of the CAFB Bombing Range

WHEREAS, the United States Air Force intends to do significant road improvement from US 60/84 south along Roosevelt Road NRR AV for approximately five (5) miles to the bombing range; and,

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County has been advised that Cannon Air Force Base anticipates that traffic on the County Road at this location will increase from an estimated fifty (50) vehicles per year to over 60,000 vehicles per year; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County desires to ensure that resident's property and the public safety is protected along this road and requests that the United States Air Force fence on both sides of the developed road to protect the resident and adjoining property; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of Roosevelt County that the Roosevelt County Commission hereby formally requests that the United States Air Force, fence citizens property on both sides of road NRR AV from US 60/84 for approximately five (5) miles to the north entrance of the Cannon Air Force Base bombing range to protect the public health safety and welfare.
