Sheriff Malin Parker is a lifelong resident of Roosevelt County and has been in Law Enforcement since 1999. Sheriff Parker has been married for 26 years and has one daughter.

Sheriff Malin Parker began his career in law enforcement as a Roosevelt County Sheriff's Reserve Deputy, after finding his true passion in life; Parker accepted a position with the Elida Police Department. Briefly a patrolman, Parker was promoted to Chief of Police for the small, rural Department. Approximately two years were spent with the Elida Police Department before Sheriff Parker was hired as a full-time Deputy with the Roosevelt County Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Parker worked in patrol for the next couple of years until he began working for the Region V Drug Task Force under the direction of former Curry County Sheriff Roger Hatcher. While working for the Region, Sheriff Parker was assigned to work Narcotics in a five county area which included, Roosevelt, Curry, De Baca, Guadalupe, and Quay Counties. While assigned to the Region, Sheriff Parker was commissioned as an agent for the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), and received awards from both the DEA and the U.S. Department of Justice for his accomplishments. Sheriff Parker has worked with all branches of the Federal government and many local Law Enforcement entities. Sheriff Parker has received numerous awards and commendations during his time working in patrol, narcotics, and investigations and was nominated as Law Enforcement Officer of the year in 2006. During his time in Law Enforcement Sheriff Parker has completed over 2,000 hours of basic and advanced training in law enforcement and has obtained the highest level of Law Enforcement Certification in the Executive status. Sheriff Parker is a NM certified general Law Enforcement Instructor, NM State firearms Instructor, and has graduated from the Match Grade Sniper School in Albuquerque NM.

In 2007 Darren Hooker was elected as Sheriff of Roosevelt County, Sheriff Parker left the Drug Task Force and accepted the position of Chief Deputy for Roosevelt County. Sheriff Parker continued in overseeing the day to day operations of the Sheriff's Office for 8 years. In January of 2015 Malin Parker was elected and sworn in as Sheriff of Roosevelt County. In 2019 Sheriff Parker was re-elected and continues to serve as Sheriff today.
