## **Program Rules**

You are currently under the supervision of the Roosevelt county DWI/Misdemeanor Compliance Program and are ordered to follow the requirements listed below. You will be under supervision until you are officially discharged. You are to refrain from drug and alcohol use during your supervision period. Periodically, you may be subject to random drug/alcohol testing. Evidence of alcohol or drug usage will be grounds for referral back to court.

- You are to notify your Compliance Officer if any personal or contact information changes within 24 hours, including but, not limited to: address, phone number, employment, emergency contact.
- 3. If you are planning to leave Roosevelt County/Curry County for a period of 24 hours or more, you must request a travel permit from your Compliance Officer.
- 4. Clothing which portrays profanity, nude images, illegal activity, or drug/alcohol images are not allowed at any check-in, class, community service, or counseling session.
- 5. You are not allowed to carry any type of weapon and/or firearms on the Roosevelt County premises.
- 6. You are responsible for providing proof of completed sanctions to our office prior to the due date assigned by your Compliance Officer.
- 7. You are responsible for appearing on time for your appointments and/or classes.
- 8. You will conduct yourself in a respectful manner toward all staff, at all times.
- 9. While waiting for your intake appointment, review your Judgement and Sentence given to you by the Court. Your Conditions of Probation are provided and you need to abide by those rules. No excuses!
- 10. Any violations of the program rules will result in you being referred back to your sentencing court.
