

RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2021-28

Participation in Local Government Road Fund Program Administered by New Mexico Department of Transportation

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$296,516.00 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$222,387.00

and

b. improvements, drainage improvements, misc, on approximately eleven and one half miles of various County roads, within the control of the Roosevelt County in Portales, New Mexico. Roosevelt County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$74,129.00

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$296,516.00

Roosevelt County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$296,516.00

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that Roosevelt County determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on December 31, 2022 and the Roosevelt County incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Roosevelt County, to enter into Cooperative Agreement CAP Control No. L200539 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project for year 2021-2022 to **Termini:** 2 miles micro seal SRR Y from NM 267 to NM 236; 2 miles caliche SRR 28 from SRR AE to SRR AG; 3 miles caliche SRR 0 from SRR 16 to NM 235; 2 miles caliche SRR 8 from SRR E to SRR G; 2 miles caliche SRR 16 from NM 206 to SRR P; 4 miles micro seal SRR AD from NM 267 to NM 480; 2 caliche SRR 0 from NM 88 to SRR 10.

Scope of work: to design construct, reconstruct blading and shaping, caliche, chip seal, micro seal rehabilitation improvements, drainage improvements, misc. administrative management and engineering certifications on approximately seventeen miles of various County Maintained Roads.

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED on this 8th day of June, 2021 by the Roosevelt County Board of Commissioners in an open meeting in Portales, New Mexico.
