



RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2021-30

**Participation in Local Government Road Fund Program Administered by New Mexico
Department of Transportation**

WHEREAS, the Roosevelt County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be **\$243,930.67** to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or **\$182,948.00**

and

- b. Improvements, drainage improvements, misc. on approximately ten miles of various County roads, within the control of the Roosevelt County in Portales, New Mexico. Roosevelt County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or **\$60,982.67**

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$243,930.67

Roosevelt County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of **\$243,930.67**

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that Roosevelt County determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

The project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on December 31, 2022 and Roosevelt County incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Roosevelt County, to enter into Cooperative Agreement SB Control Number L200546 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project for year 2021 – 2022 to **Termini**: 2 miles micro seal SRR P from SRR 4 to SRR 6; 1 mile caliche SRR Q from SRR 8 to SRR 9; 1.5 miles cal/cs SRR 4 from SRR L ½ to SRR N; 2 miles caliche SRR 14 from SRR AP to SRR AR; 0.5 mile cal/cs Springwood Addition; 2 miles caliche SRR O from NM 88 to SRR 3; 1 mile SRR S from SRR 11 to SRR 12;

Scope of work: design, reconstruction, Blading and shaping, caliche, chip seal, micro seal, pavement rehabilitation and improvements, drainage improvements, construction management, and misc. on approximately ten miles of various County Maintained Roads.



NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF ROOSEVELT COUNTY, that the completed SB application is approved.

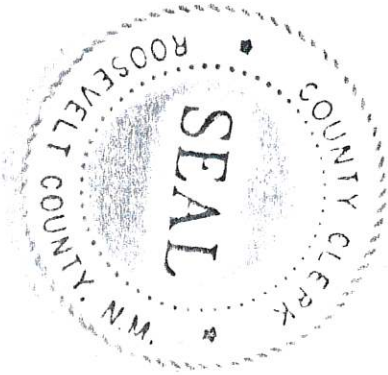
