



## Tenant Users Liability Insurance Protection (TULIP)

### Purpose:

Provides low cost general liability coverage to third party users of various county-owned venues and facilities for events such as weddings and birthday parties.

### How:

When a resident inquires about renting a county-owned facility or venue, direct them to obtain a free quote for coverage at <https://www.intactspecialty.com/entertainment>
