



**Resolution Number: 2021-44**

**Participation in Capital Outlay Program Administered by New Mexico Department of Transportation**

**Whereas**, Roosevelt County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement.

**Whereas**, the total cost of the project is estimated at \$450,648 to be funded by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 100% or \$300,000; and
- b. Roosevelt County's proportional matching share shall be 0% or \$150,648

**TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$450,648**

Roosevelt County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of **\$300,000.00**

**Now therefore**, be it resolved in official session the Roosevelt County Board of Commission determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing. The agreement terminates on June 30, 2025 (Laws of 2021) and Roosevelt County incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

**Now therefore**, be it further resolved by the Roosevelt County Board of Commissioners to enter into Cooperative Agreement Control Number C2213035 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Capital Outlay (Laws of 2021) To design, plan, blade, shape, reshape, rehab, improve, construct reconstruct improvements, and administrative management. These roads include Chip seal, Fog seal, caliche, PMM concrete: .25 mile cal/cs Springwood Addition to SRR P; .25 mile cal/cs Cottonwood Place to SRR P; 2 miles cal/cs SRR O bet NM88 to SRR 3; 1 mile cal SRR 11 bet NM 206 to SRR S; 2 miles cal SRR 20 bet NM 206 to SRR T; .5 mile cal SRR 16 to SRR W West; 2 miles cal NRR AP bet NM 60/84 to NRR 13; .5 mile cal Indian Hills bet NM 267 to Apache Hills; .2 mile cal Apache Hills bet Indian Hills to SRR V; 1 mile SRR Z bet NM 267 to SRR 4; These roads are heavily trafficked by residents and business operations. Priority for repair and replacement will be determined by the Road Superintendent and the County Commission. Work will be completed in-house by Roosevelt County Road Department, In addition to construction management, administrative and engineering management as mandated by State and NMDOT, within the controls of Roosevelt County in Portales, New Mexico.

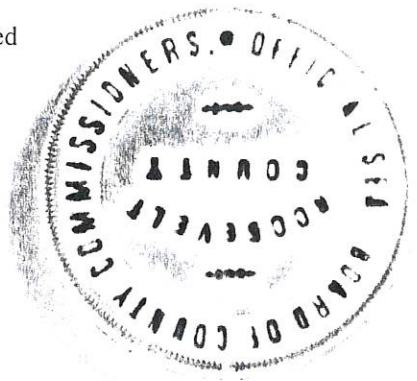
