

RESOLUTION 2021-45

Delegating Authority to the County Manager to Issue a Special Dispenser's Permit

WHEREAS, ownership of an alcohol dispenser's license may be leased in the same manner as provided for under the Liquor Control Act as defined by §60-6B-16 NMSA; and,

WHEREAS, all leases of a dispenser's license are subject to the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Administrative Act at §15.11.25.8 requires that the application for a special dispenser's permit must be accompanied by written permission from the governing body of the local option district where the public or private event is to be held, and where such alcoholic beverages will be sold or served; and

WHEREAS, it is often impossible to convene a special County Commission meeting for purposes of approving such permits; and

WHEREAS, approval of an application for a special dispenser's permit shall be delegated to the County Manager, for his or her approval, unless there is a regularly scheduled County Commission meeting which will allow for the granting of written permission by vote of the County Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Roosevelt County Commissioners that, written permission for a special dispenser's permit by the Board of Roosevelt County Commissioners shall be delegated to the County Manager, or their designee, for approval unless there is a regularly scheduled County Commission meeting which will allow for the timely approval and submission of the application for such special dispenser's permit.
