



PROCLAMATION

Declaring May as Motorcycle Awareness Month

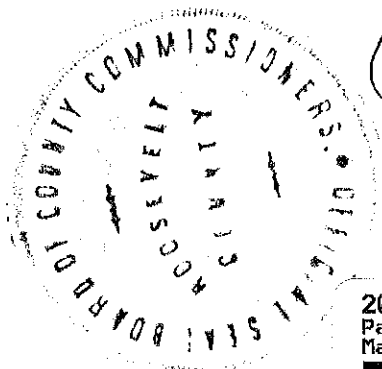
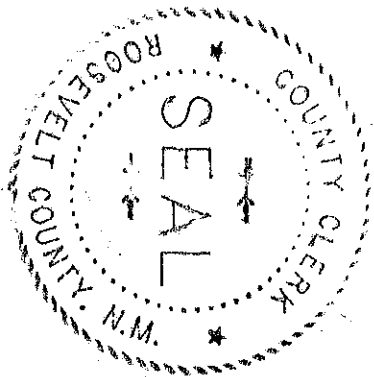
