

## **RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2022-22**

## Resolution for Participation in Local Government Road Fund Program Administered by New Mexico Department of Transportation

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$166,667.00 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$125,000.00

and

b. improvements, drainage improvements, misc. on approximately seventeen miles of various County roads, within the control of the Roosevelt County in Portales, New Mexico. Roosevelt County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$41,667.00

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$166,667.00

Roosevelt County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$166,667.00

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that Roosevelt County determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on December 31, 2023 and the Roosevelt County incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Roosevelt County, to enter into Cooperative Agreement COOP Control No. L200558 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation LGRF Project for year 2022 – 2023 to Termini: 1 mile C SRR 8 from SRR F to SRR G; 1 mile C/CS/MS SRR Y from NM 267 to SRR 6; 1 mile MS SRR 8 from SRR S to SRR T; 1 C SRR S from SRR 11 to SRR 12; 1 mile C SRR 34 from SRR Y to SRR Z; 2 miles C SRR F from SRR 14 to SRR 16; 2 miles AL from SRR 22 to SRR 24; 2 miles C SRR AG from NM 114 to SRR 24; 1 mile C SRR Z from SRR 34 to SRR 35; 5 miles C NRR AP from NM 60/84 to NRR16;

Scope of work: to design construct, reconstruct blading and shaping, caliche, chip seal and overlay, PMM, fog seal rehabilitation improvements, drainage improvements, misc. administrative management and engineer certifications on approximately seventeen miles of various County roads.



NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF ROOSEVELT COUNTY, that the completed COOP application is approved.
