

RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2022-23

Resolution for Participation in Local Government Road Fund Program Administered by New Mexico Department of Transportation

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$334,292.00 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$250,719.00

and

b. improvements, drainage improvements, misc. on approximately eighteen miles of various County roads, within the control of the Roosevelt County in Portales, New Mexico. Roosevelt County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$83,573.00

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$334,292.00

Roosevelt County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$334,292.00

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that Roosevelt County determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on December 31, 2023 and the Roosevelt County incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Roosevelt County, to enter into Cooperative Agreement CAP Control No. L200582 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation LGRF Project for year 2022 – 2023 to **Termini:** 1.5 miles C/CS Highlands; 2 miles C SRR O from NM 88 to SRR 10; 2 miles C SRR 16 from NM 206 to SRR P; 1 mile MS SRR 6 from SRR U to SRR V; 1 mile MS SRR P from SRR 6 to SRR 7; 2 miles C SRR G from SRR 8 to NM 88; 1 mile C SRR S from SRR 11 to SRR 12; 1 mile C SRR 7 from SRR AC to SRR AD; 4 mile C/CS/MS SRR AD from NM 480 to NM 267; 1 mile C/CS SRR S1/2 from SRR 7 to SRR 8; 2 miles C SRR 33 from NM 206 to SRR P;.

Scope of work: to design construct, reconstruct blading and shaping, caliche, chip seal, fog seal and PMM rehabilitation improvements, drainage improvements, misc. administrative management and engineering certifications on approximately eighteen miles of various County Maintained Roads.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF ROOSEVELT COUNTY, that the completed CAP application is approved.
