## **Supporting General Obligation Bond Issue 3**

WHEREAS, funds for capital expenditures at certain state postsecondary institutions are necessary for the maintenance of facilities, as described in the 2022 Capital Projects General Obligation Bond Act; and

WHEREAS, revenues from General Obligation Bond Acts are a traditional and practical source of funding to meet such needs; and

**WHEREAS**, General Obligation Bond Issue 3 would make \$215 million available for 17 public education projects statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, through General Obligation Bond Issue 3, Eastern New Mexico University in Portales would receive \$9 million to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip a new Student Academic Services Building, ENMU-Roswell would receive \$2.475 million;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Roosevelt County Commissioners support General Obligation Bond Issue 3 that will be on the ballot in New Mexico's November 8, 2022, General Election.
