Agricultural Lands Instructions & Application

Owners of agricultural property must make application to the County Assessor in which the special valuation method is claimed. **The burden of demonstrating primary agricultural use is placed on the owner of the land.** Objective evidence of bona fide agricultural use must be produced for the land to be valued as agricultural land. The value of land used primarily for agricultural purposes shall be determined on the basis of the land's capacity to produce agricultural products (NMSA 7-36-20).
