WHEREAS, the men and women of the Roosevelt County Detention Center unceasingly provide a vital public service, and put their lives on the line daily. This team has remained committed to excellence after earning and achieving re-accreditation by the New Mexico Association of Counties Adult Detention Professional Standards in 2019.


