## **RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2020-23**

## Supporting General Obligation Bond Issue C

**WHEREAS**, funds for capital expenditures at certain state postsecondary institutions are necessary for the maintenance of facilities, as described in the 2020 Capital Projects General Obligation Bond Act; and

**WHEREAS**, revenues from General Obligation Bond Acts are a traditional and practical source of funding to meet such needs; and

WHEREAS, through General Obligation Bond Issue C, Eastern New Mexico University in Portales would receive \$8 million for the renovation of Roosevelt Science Center and infrastructure projects; Clovis Community College will receive \$1.075 million for renovations and infrastructure improvements campus-wide including repair of roofs, parking lots and HVAC.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Roosevelt County Commissioners support General Obligation Bond Issue C that will be on the ballot in New Mexico's November 3, 2020, General Election.

**APPROVED, PASSED and ADOPTED** this 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2020 by the Roosevelt County Board of Commissioners.
