

RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2023-25

Resolution for Participation in Local Government Road Fund Program Administered by New Mexico Department of Transportation

WHEREAS, the Roosevelt County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$167,619.00 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$125,714.00

and

b. Improvements, drainage improvements, misc. on approximately twenty miles of various County roads, within the control of the Roosevelt County in Portales, New Mexico. Roosevelt County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$41,905.00

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$167,619.00

Roosevelt County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$167,619.00

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that Roosevelt County determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

The project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on December 31, 2024 and Roosevelt County incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Roosevelt County, to enter into Cooperative Agreement SB Control Number L200616 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project for year 2023 – 2024 to Termini: 1 mile C/CS SRR V from NM 236 to NM 267; 2 miles C SRR 14 from SRR AP to SRR AR; 1 mile MS SRR P from HWY 70 to SRR 4; 1 mile C SRR 11 from NM 206 to SRR S; 3 miles C SRR 28 from HWY 70 to SRR AU; 5 miles C SRR AP from SRR 14 to SRR 19; 1 mile C SRR P from SRR 10 to SRR 11; 5 miles C SRR 16 from NM 206 to SRR W; 1 mile C/CS SRR S ½ from SRR 7 to SRR 8;

Scope of work: design, reconstruction, Blading and shaping, caliche, chip seal, micro seal, pavement rehabilitation and improvements, drainage improvements, construction management, and misc. on approximately twenty miles of various County Maintained Roads.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF ROOSEVELT COUNTY, that the completed SB application is approved.
