Increasing the Salaries of Elected Officials in Roosevelt County, New Mexico

WHEREAS, the salary for elected county officials is established by statue; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County is classified as a B-High County; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission approved Resolution 2022-29 on July 12,2022 specifying the Salaries of the elected officials in Roosevelt County; and

WHEREAS, the current salaries of Roosevelt County Officials are:

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Roosevelt County Commissioners. Which is the governing body thereof, to raise the salaries of elected officials in Roosevelt County an additional ten percent, (10%), which is still below the statutory limit pertaining to their salary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Roosevelt County, pursuant to state law, that the salaries for elected positions in Roosevelt County shall be as follows:

- 1. Effective January 1, 2025, the salary for the County Clerk and the County Treasurer will be \$72,765 and the salary for the District I and District II County Commissioners will be \$27,625.
- 2. Effective January 1, 2027, the salary for Sheriff will be \$78,650, and the salary for Assessor will be \$72,765, the salary for the Probate Judge will be \$24,225, and the salary for the District III, District IV, and District V County Commissioners will be \$27,625.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the appointed Chief Deputy Clerk, Chief Deputy Treasurer, Chief Deputy Assessor, and Chief Deputy Sheriff salaries shall be set at ninety-three percent (93%) of the office's elected official salary once the new salaries go into effect, and shall remain at ninety-three percent (93%) until effective. The appointed Executive Assistant to the Sheriff shall remain at no more than seventy percent (70%) of the Sheriff's salary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no salary increase shall take effect until the first day of the term of an elected county official who takes office on or after January 1, 2025, nor shall they go into effect until the first day of the term for any elected official who takes office on or after January 1, 2027.
