

RESOLUTION PROPOSING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TAX BALLOT QUESTION

The Board of Education met in regular session on the 9th day of March, 2026.

WHEREAS the Public School Capital Improvements Act (Sections 22-25-1 through 22-25-11 NMSA 1978) authorizes submission of a capital improvements tax question to voters; and

WHEREAS the Board has determined that the question should be submitted to the voters of the District;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a Special Mail Ballot Election shall be held Thursday, August 13, 2026.

STATUTORY BALLOT QUESTION

PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS (\$2.00 MILL) TAX QUESTION

Shall the Board of Education of the Elida Municipal School District No. 2, Counties of Chaves and Roosevelt, State of New Mexico, be authorized to impose a property tax of \$2.00 on each \$1,000.00 of net taxable value of the property allocated to the District under the Property Tax Code for property tax years 2027, 2028, 2029, 2030, 2031, and 2032 for capital improvements in the District including payments made with respect to lease-purchase arrangements as defined in the Education Technology Equipment Act or the Public School Lease Purchase Act?
